ISSUES TO CONSIDER IN FORMING AN RTA

- Current budget is funded 79.3% by City and 20.7% by County.
- The issue of weighting votes by members of the board of the RTA needs to be determined. The "straw man" proposed voting structure of RTA is 50/50
- City currently provides over \$400,000 in support services to CTS. These costs would have to be paid by the RTA to the City or another entity
- The City, according to the consultant's report has a current depreciated value of \$32 million in CTS assets. \$3.1 million of this is local direct City match dollars in capital investment.
- A large number of CTS employees are in the City's retirement plan. An RTA would probably be in VRS.
- The issue of how to fund transit services above the current level of CTS service.
- The issue of how to allocate the cost of regional transit services between members of the RTA needs to be determined.
